- Cobbs bread order do we have a volunteer who would be willing to do this for this year? Mahdieh Hossini was trained and can slice bread most of the time. She is not able to bring her toddler so would benefit from a back up plan or person going forward. We currently do not have a Cobbs pick up schedule as of yet. Alyson McKague will provide updated schedule when recieved.
- Hot Lunch is typically run through School Council volunteers who provide pick up of the lunch or supplies and the distribution to classrooms. Alyson posts on School Cash for purchase (prices based on costs of supplies), counts, orders and provides class lists with the orders on the day of distribution (then returned to Alyson after hot lunch). Pizza and hot dogs are easiest with hot dogs being most profitable. McDonalds last year was by far the most profitable ever, but need to have a volunteer pick up in Airdrie. Preliminary Numbers Indicate RVS' Enrolment Will Continue to Grow

RVS enrolment is 29,307 students, an increase of 700 students from September of 2023. Enrolment numbers fluctuate and these are preliminary numbers.

Locations for Additional Modulars to Support Ongoing Enrolment Pressures

Four Airdrie schools, two Cochrane schools as well as Springbank, Chestermere and Crossfield will benefit from the new and relocated modular classroom units approved by the Government of Alberta on July 23. RVS will receive 12 new modular classroom units and an additional 12 modular relocations. These units will be located at schools where they are most needed to help alleviate the ongoing enrolment pressures across the division and be ready for use beginning with the 2025/26 school year.

Horseshoe Crossing High School Turf Field Vendor Selected

The Board awarded the request for proposal so that the turf field project at Horseshoe Crossing High School can proceed.

Ward Boundary Review Summary Presented

The Board engaged the services of a consultant to conduct a review of the current boundaries of the wards within RVS. This process was undertaken in response to a population increase from 2016 of 32 per cent within RVS' communities. Board Policy 29 – Ward Structure requires a ward boundary review be conducted to ensure effective and equitable representation by population is maintained. Next steps – planning committee on Oct 3 to review consultant recommendation, and final decision on Oct 17.
